Marshall was a legend not only for his outsize personality but also for the way he seemed to disappear when behind his trademark Leica camera, thereby producing some of the most intimate and iconic images in music history.

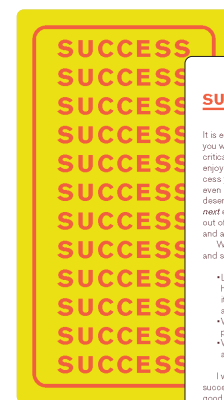
THE ARTIST'S DECK

It is easier to get the externally validating thing you want—also show, book deal, fellowship, critical praise, breakthrough sales—than to enjoy it in real time. When you get the success you want, you may feel embarrassed and even ashamed. You may feel you don't really deserve it, or immediately look toward the next external goalpost, which takes you right out of the present. You might feel pressure and as though you are overexposed.

- When you experience success of any size and shape, do the following:
- Look in the mirror with a hand over your heart (don't roll your eyes at me, just do it) and feel and express your pride in your accomplishment.
- Write a gratitude list about what happened.
- When others congratulate you, breathe in and say, "Thank you," and nothing else.

I want you experience the moments of success as they happen. You get to enjoy the good things that happen.

FEAR

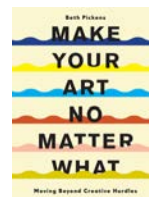
All day long our minds buzz with fear. Some of it is useful and keeps us from danger, but much of it can be discarded. The great majority of fears that creep up about your practice can be challenged or ignored. First, we have to become aware of our fears and recognize them as such. Without such awareness, we mistake our fearful thoughts as fundamental truths.

Stop. What are you afraid of as an artist? Play out one fearful thought for consideration. This is awareness.

Then, accept the fear. It is not evidence of anything besides your humanness. Say it aloud and give it your focus. Whose voice is this? Where did the fear come from? Simply as a thought exercise, imagine what would happen in your life if this fear were false.
