The author has signed an exclusive first-look pact with Skydance Television, under which writer Ben Watkins will adapt a number of books for the studio including *Women's Murder Club, Michael Bennett, Private* and the upcoming *Jane Smith* and *Holmes, Miss Marple and Poe* (published internationally as *Homes, Margaret & Poe*) with Patterson serving as executive producer on all projects alongside Skydance.

Patterson had been based at Entertainment One since 2020, and before that had a long history with CBS Studios. Patterson's new pact extends his relationship with Skydance TV, with whom he's adapting *Cross* as an Amazon Prime series to premiere in November 2024. Patterson's previous TV credits include CBS' *Instinct* and *Zoo*. His *Women's Murder Club* series was previously adapted as a short-lived drama for ABC.

Jane Smith

Dylan literally wrote the book on the psychology of murder, and he and Elizabeth have solved cases that have baffled conventional detectives. But the sociopath they're facing this time is the opposite of a textbook case. There's no time to study for the test he's about to give them. And if they fail, they die.


