

While hunting for Kayla's killer, Ruben is persuaded to help a distraught mother get to the bottom of what happened to her own child who was abducted years earlier. When a third child goes missing, things get twisty. What Ruben doesn't know is that not only are all these victims tied together, but he is the one holding the rope. A rope, at the very end of which, hangs an impossible truth. Propulsive and surprising, this is also a very funny read. A standalone commercial detective thriller is the first in a planned series.


Just business? Over my dead body.

It was a dark and stormy night in 1991 when a magician took over the bridge of the Oceanos passenger liner. The ship started taking in water in the auxiliary engine room just a few hours after it had set sail. 



Refusing to be a victim, Emmanuel Taban overcame extreme poverty, racism and xenophobia to become the man he is today. 

William Henry 'Krom' Hendricks was the first sportsman to be formally barred from representing South Africa on the basis of race. This made his exclusion from South Africa's tour of England in 1894 and subsequent Test series all the more unjust. Too Black to Wear Whites documents Hendricks's tireless struggle for recognition and the public controversies around his exclusion. Krom Hendricks' life story is told here for the first time in a fascinating drama that describes the formation of a segregated South Africa through the career of an exceptional cricketer who challenged the boundaries of the system.



The process triggers splintered memories of dark family secrets and hints of culpability.
